CROSSLANDS RESOURCES SIGNS UP MARK BUSHELL

Crosslands Resources has recruited Mark Bushell, adding new strength to its sustainability portfolio.

The ore is mined, crushed and screened at the Jack Hills mine and then transported 640 kilometres by road haulage to the port of Geraldton, where it is loaded and shipped to customers in China and Korea.

Crosslands is jointly owned (50/50) by Murchison Metals Ltd and Mitsubishi Development Pty Ltd a subsidiary of Mitsubishi Corporation, Japan's largest general trading company.
