WE'RE AT THE HEART OF MID-WEST IRON ORE

Crosslands Resources Ltd is the owner of the Jack Hills iron ore project located in Western Australia's mid-west. We are jointly owned (50/50) by Murchison Metals Ltd and Mitsubishi Development Pty Ltd.

WE HAVE THE MID-WEST COMMUNITY AT HEART

Crosslands is a local company, and supporter of the local community. Our @Heart Crosslands Community Support Program is designed to support projects in communities where we operate, that benefit a broad range of community members. Our program aims to connect with these communities and assist in building capacity within them.

Based on community research, we have identified priority *focus areas* for our support.

1. Education & Training – projects that promote academic achievement, training and skills development in the community.
2. Indigenous Programs – projects that support Indigenous economic and social enhancement, promote cultural heritage or build Indigenous capacity.
3. Healthy Communities – community-based projects that help develop a vibrant community and create a sense of place.
4. Support Services – assistance to help the community access priority services (eg, childcare, healthcare).

All projects we support will need to fall into at least one of these focus areas. Our support will be directed towards the local communities where we operate in the mid-west.

Our mining, logistics and shipping operations are in the City of Geraldton-Greenough and Shires of Cue and Murchison.

We undertake road haulage through the Shires of Yalgoo, Mullewa and Mount Magnet.

Other nearby communities include the Shires of Chapman Valley, Meekatharra and Northampton.

CRITERIA - HOW WILL WE DECIDE WHICH PROJECTS TO SUPPORT?

For a project to be successful, it must benefit the communities where we operate and fit into at least one of our focus areas. We will then assess each application against the following criteria.

- ✓ The project has potential to involve a significant number of people
- ✓ The project aims to achieve broad community benefits and has broad community support
- ✓ The project is sustainable and has substantial financial contributions from other sources (Crosslands can contribute between \$200 and \$2000 to your project)
- ✓ There is evidence of lasting benefits to your organisation
- ✓ The project is long term, rather than one off

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR SUPPORT?

To be eligible for support, you should be a bona fide community group or organisation with not for profit status. If you have a project that you think we would support, but are not a legally constituted organisation, you could ask your local council or another community organisation in your region, to apply on your behalf. You will need to obtain their consent before doing this.

Unfortunately, you will not be eligible if you or your project:

- Does not benefit the communities where we operate
- Does not fit within one of our focus areas
- Are applying for support as an individual
- Discriminates on the basis of race, colour, creed, gender or national origin
- Are applying for a project that has religious purposes
- Are a political organisation
- Is hazardous or dangerous
- Will cause harm to the environment
- Is a request for advertising
- Is for travel to attend conferences or other events

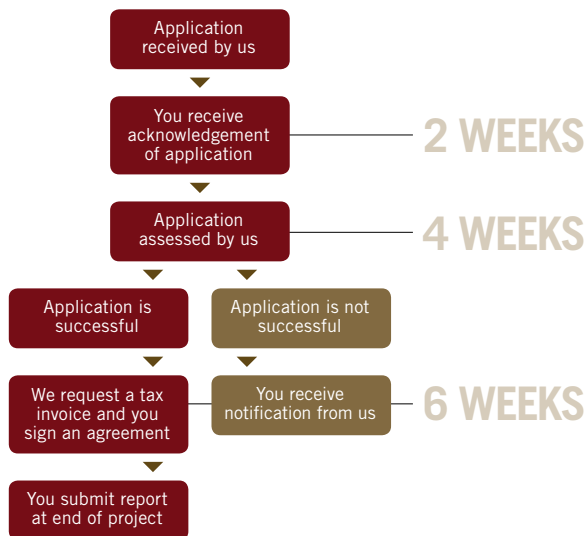
HOW DO YOU APPLY?

If you are eligible for support, please address all sections on our application form. Once your application is completed, send it by mail to: Manager Community and Public Relations, Crosslands Resources Ltd, PO Box 1454, West Perth, WA 6872 or by email to: sponsorships@crosslands.com.au

Please ensure your application arrives to us by the due date of 15 March or 15 September.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER YOUR APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED?

1. Once we have received your application, we will contact you if we have any queries. You will also receive an email from us within 2 weeks, confirming that we have received it.
2. Your application will be considered against the criteria, within 4 weeks.
3. If your application is successful, we will contact you within 6 weeks and ask you to send us a tax invoice so that we can make payment. You will be asked to sign an agreement that outlines our expectations of the benefits you will provide to us. At the completion of your project, you will need to provide us with a report.
4. If your application is unsuccessful, we will notify you within 6 weeks.
